

Varsity Letter Requirements

Every athlete that completes a Varsity season and meets the following requirements will receive a letter. (The E)

The requirements for varsity letters cover all sports:

- Must be in good athletic and academic standing- and academically eligible during all seasons of said sport.
- Show marked improvement during the season and from the previous season.
- Be of good character, a teammate, and team player.
- Attend all practices, games, meets or matches unless excused by the coach.
- At the discretion of the head coach, only with the approval of the AD.

Only athletes that meet the following requirements may also earn a sport specific varsity patch at the completion of the season. Please note that this usually only applies to sophomores, juniors and seniors as most freshman do not qualify as varsity players. These players are selected by the coach.

The requirements for varsity letter patches cover all sports:

- Must be in good athletic and academic standing- and academically eligible during all seasons of said sport.
- Injured players may receive a letter if in the opinion of the head coach he/she would have participated enough if they had not been injured, and also served the team in some capacity while injured.
- Show marked improvement during the season and from the previous season.
- Be of good character, a teammate, and team player.
- Attend all practices, games, meets or matches unless excused by the coach.
- Contribute to the teams success.
- Regular member of the varsity team – as ECS has one team, this is defined as a player that plays in at least half of the scheduled games as a varsity player.
- At the discretion of the head coach, only with the approval of the AD.
